Subject: Invitation to submit contributions to ICM 2006

Dear Colleague,

We kindly remind you that the deadline to submit contributions to the International Congress of Mathematicians (ICM2006) is March 30th, 2006.

Contributions may be proposed by registered participants in the form of short communications, posters or mathematical software presentations. Abstracts have to be submitted to the Local Program Committee through the Congress website before March 30th. The Local Program Committee will notify authors of acceptance or rejection of their contribution before May 30th. Abstracts of accepted contributions will be published in the abstract book of the Congress.

SHORT COMMUNICATIONS

Short communications should be presented orally within up to 20 minutes, including discussion. Rooms for short communications are equipped with an overhead projector. Further instructions and a submission form are available at

POSTERS

Poster sessions provide pleasant interaction between colleagues, allowing discussions in an informal and relaxed atmosphere. The Local Program Committee strongly recommends scientific contributions in the form of posters and encourages participation in the POSTER COMPETITION.

Mathematical originality, new solutions to relevant problems, or unusual fields of application will be greatly appreciated.
